Artistic Discoveries (Poster Presentation) Rules

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The team can consist maximum of two members.
- 2. The participants of the team must be from the same college. Registration is mandatory for both the members.
- 3. Names and Institute name should appear on the backside of the poster.
- 4. Participant has to explain their poster content to the committee, to the visitors during the session. Marks will be based on theme, creativity, efforts taken, scientific content and presentation.
- 5. Participants has to bring there own pins, Poster papers, gum, or two sided tape to place their poster properly.
- 6. The team member/members should be present during the poster presentation session.
- 7. All lettering and diagrams should be large enough to be read from a minimum of 2 feet.
- 8. Poster Size: maximum 1m x 1m (Hand Made).
- 9. Participants should not enroll their names and college/Institutes name on the poster.
- 10. Participant should submit their hand made poster to respective Coordinators.
- 11. The content should not contain any sort of vulgarity.
- 12. Digital Posters are not accepted.

Judging Criteria:

- **Topic Selection :** The topic should be relevant to the poster presentation competition, well-defined, focused, interesting, and engaging.
- **Poster Uniqueness :** The poster should present new and innovative ideas using a creative approach and be visually appealing and engaging.
- **Topic Presentation:** The information on the poster should be well-organized, easy to understand, and presented using clear and concise language, effectively using visuals to support the information.

- **Questions and Answers :** The presenter should be able to answer questions from the judges in a clear, concise, and informative way, demonstrating enthusiasm and knowledge about the topic while engaging the judges in a discussion.
- **Overall Poster Impact:** The poster should be visually appealing and easy to read, neatly and professionally presented, and an overall effective way to communicate the information.

Additional Rules:

- Participants will have five minutes to present their poster before the panel.
- Violation of any mentioned rule can lead to disqualification of the poster at any given time.
- The organizers reserve the right to change or update the rules of the contest at any time and will do their best to inform the participants about the same.
